- Bachelor's degree from a recognized University, with a minimum of Second Class (Lower Division) in a related field of Study.
- ii. Candidates with 3rd Class Honors Degree, HND or its equivalent will be required to have in addition a Postgraduate Diploma (PGD) in Public Administration.
- iii. Any other qualifications recognized by the Senate of NOUN

M.Phil/Ph.D.

The Master of Philosophy M.Phil/Ph.D in Public Administration is open to anyone who is desirous of pursuing PhD degree in Public Administration but who could not gain admission due to a shortfall in his/her CGPA not meeting the NUC BMAS of 4.0 or average of B grade (60%).

Applicants will still be required to satisfy NOUN matriculation requirements and have M.Sc. with CGPA not less 3.5 in Public Administration, Political Science, Local Government Studies, International Relations and Diplomacy, Industrial Relations and other related disciplines which includes coursework and research thesis from NOUN or any recognized University by Senate.

Ph.D.

Applicants for this programme will be required to satisfy NOUN matriculation requirements and have M.Sc in Public Administration, Political Science, Local Government Studies, International Relations and Diplomacy, Industrial Relations and any other allied disciplines with at least an average of **B grade (60%) or CGPA 4.0** which includes coursework and research thesis from NOUN or any recognized University by the Senate of NOUN.

EVALUATION

Tutor Marked Assignments (TMA):

As part of the evaluation mechanism, students will be required to do TMA in each course. This constitutes 30% of the examination score.

End of semester Examination:

Except otherwise stated, each course will culminate in an end of semester examination. The examination for each course constitutes 70% of the total score. The end of semester examination is 30+70=100%

Instructional Methods:

The method of instruction is by ODL mode which involves online facilitation via zoom, instructional videos, highly interactive course materials which are in prints and on the web, CD roms and in flash drives, Tv and Radio course deliveries, Seminars, Workshops, face-to-face and virtual Project supervision, Virtual project moderation and defence. It is worthy to note that to excel in NOUN, a student must be technologically savvy.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for graduation a student must pass all the compulsory and chosen elective courses. M.Sc. and Ph.D. students must, in addition, defend their thesis.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

B.Sc.

Admission into 100 Level

To be admitted into B.Sc. Public Administration, a candidate must possess:

i.....Five credits in relevant subjects (including English Language, Mathematics and Economics/Commerce/Government/History) at the WASC/SSCE/NECO at not more than two sittings.

Admission into 200 Level:

iii.Candidates with Advanced Level passes in at least 2 relevant subjects in addition to a minimum of 3 credit passes in GCE O' Level subjects may be considered for admission into the 200 Level.

vi. Admission into 300 level: candidates with HND certificate in Public Administration, Secretarial Administration/Studies, Office

Technology and Management can be considered for admission into the 300 level.

PGD

To be admitted into **PGD** Public Administration, a candidate must possess:

- i. At least a third-class degree in Public Administration, Political Science, Sociology, International Relations, Human Resources, Business Administration, or any other related Social Sciences discipline.
- ii. At least a second-class (honors) degree, for applicants from other programmes not mentioned in (i) above.
- iii. Candidates who possess HND with Lower Credit in Public Administration or other relevant courses can also be considered for admission into this programme.

MPA

Candidates for admission into Master of Public Administration programmes should possess either or a combination of the following:

- i. A Bachelor's degree from a recognized University, with a minimum of Second Class (Lower Division) in a related field of Study.
- ii. Candidates with 3rd Class Honours Degree, HND or its equivalent will be required to have in addition a Postgraduate Diploma (PGD) in Public Administration.
- iii. Candidates with professional qualifications and with at least 5 years cognate experience in executive positions may be considered for admission into the MPA programme. Such candidates must in addition fulfil the NOUN matriculations requirements.

Candidates for admission into Master of Science (M.Sc) Public Administration should possess either or a combination of the following:
