

Duration of the Programme

The duration of the three programmes will run for 3 or 4 years, depending on the point or level of entry.

Graduation Requirements

Every undergraduate student would determine and be conversant with the minimum credits required before graduation. Such knowledge is needed to guide them in spreading their academic engagements throughout the 8 or 6 semesters they will pursue their studies. In the three programmes, students admitted at the 100 level earn a minimum of 120 credit units. In comparison, those admitted at the 200 level needs a minimum of 90 credit units to graduate.

Apart from the above, Students must also complete and received a pass grade in teaching practice courses (EDU216 Special Methods (Micro Teaching /School Visits), EDU335 Teaching Practice I, EDU336 Post Teaching Practice Evaluation & Remediation, EDU435 Teaching Practice II) and EDU499/EDU420 Research Project

Students must have at least 75% attendance in all facilitations, tutorials, and practical training sessions to qualify for the semester examination in any course.

The Tutor Marked Assignment (TMA), which is 30% of the final student grade, would be administered in the facilitation period. The semester examinations would be conducted at the end of every semester, and they carry 70% of the total weight of each course. These examinations can either be administered as e-examination (CBT) or pen-on-paper examinations (essay type).

Programme Delivery Method

The NOUN employs a range of delivery methods to take education to the people and make learning an enjoyable activity. These methods include:

- Printed instructional materials, audio, video tapes and CD -ROMs.
- Electronic transmission of materials in multimedia (voice, data, graphics, video, zoom).

Study Centres in each of the geo-political zones, states and local government areas shall perform critical roles in the delivery of instruction. Study Centres are resource places where students pick up a course and other study materials and interact with instructional facilitators and tutors, student counsellors, study centre directors and other students. Other learner support facilities, including internet browsing, e-mailing, library and communication channels, are also available at the study centres.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Business Education Programme

- UME candidates entering at 100 level must obtain 5 credit passes at G.C.E./WASC level, SSCE or merit in T.C. II including English Language and Mathematics in not more than two sittings.
- N.C.E. with an overall merit pass or above in related field, provided the candidate also has at least five credits or its equivalent including credit passes in Mathematics and English.
- Diploma in any area of education provided the candidate also has at least five credits at 'O' level including English Language and Mathematics.



English Programme

- UME candidates entering at 100 level must have five (5) credits pass in SSC/NTC/NBC/TCII/GCE O' level at not more than two (2) sittings in English Language, Literature in English and other relevant subjects. A credit pass in Mathematics is required.
- Direct Entry candidates entering at 200 level must have a minimum of merit pass in English Language and in two (2) other subjects as well as credits in 5 relevant O' level subjects including English Language, Mathematics and Literature in English.

French Programme

- UME candidates at 100 level must have five (5) credits in SSSC or the GCE "O" level in French (or its equivalent e.g. Niveau I of Alliance Francaise Certificate) and English and other relevant subjects at not more than two (2) sittings. A credit in Mathematics is required
- For Direct Entry, candidates entering at 200 level with NCE certificate must have a minimum of merit pass in French and in two (2) other subjects as well as credits in 5 relevant O' level subjects including English Language and Mathematics. Candidates that have NOUN Diploma in French or equivalent Diploma in French may be considered.
- **Immersion Programme at French Language Village:** At 300Level French students go for immersion programme at Nigeria French Language Village, Badagry, Lagos State, i.e. all 300L French courses are done at the Village.

Note: ND holders (with education background) may be considered for admission at 200 levels in special areas with a provision that they will take all 100 level education courses and some GST courses. HND programmes have no education bias; therefore, HND graduates cannot go for Business Education, English Education and French Education programmes unless at 100 level with required 'O' level grades
